7)Orientation program at DBC Golaghat

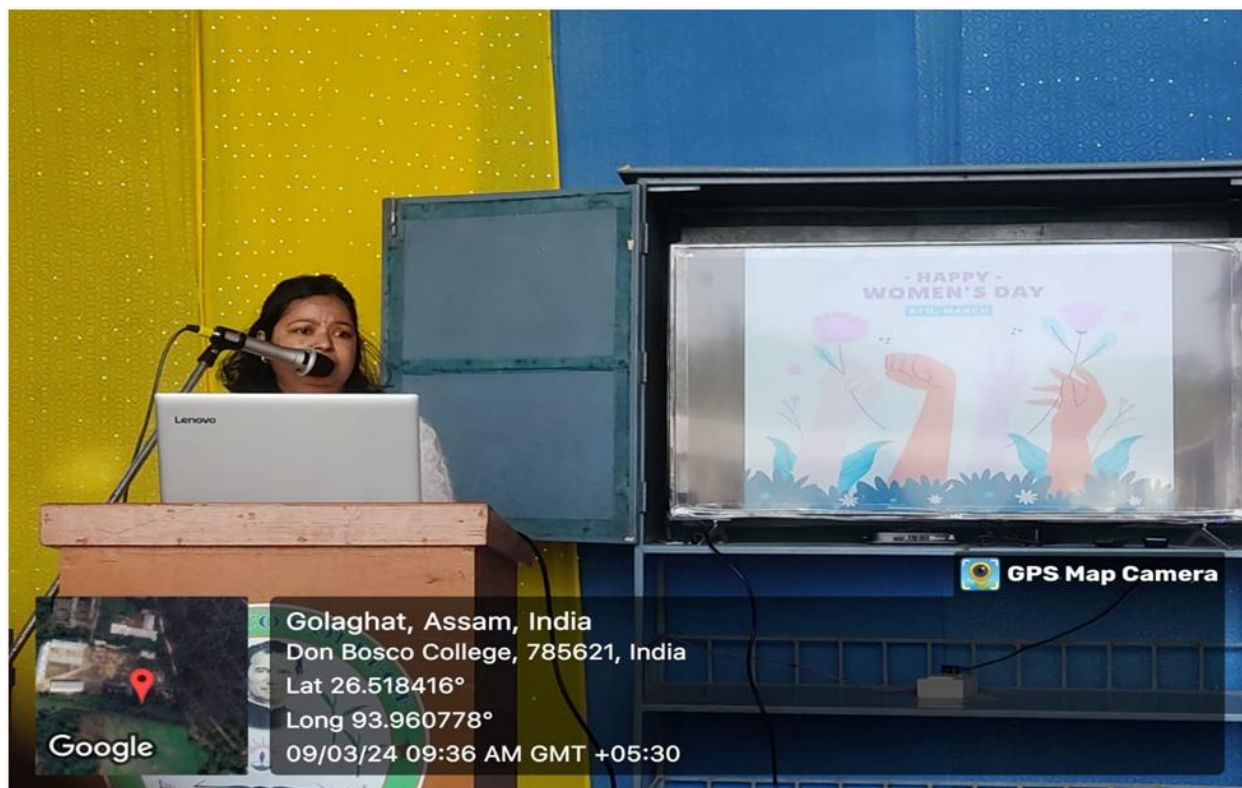
