As recommended by the 121th Meeting of the Under Graduate Board held on 25.04.2019, the 116th Meeting of the Academic Council held on 30.04.2019 vide *Resolution No. 24* has approved partial modifications in *Clauses 2(i)(m), 2.5(i)(a), 3.1(c)(i) and 8.2* of the *Dibrugarh University Regulations for the Under Graduate Programmes in the Choice Based Credit System, 2018*, which will come into effect from the *academic session 2019-2020*. The Regulations (modified) enclosed herewith as *Annexure A* supersedes all earlier editions of same.

The Choice Based Credit System going to be implemented in the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Comm. Programmes of Dibrugarh University w.e.f. academic session 2019-2020 shall be governed by these Regulations.

STRUCTURE OF COURSES FOR ARTS:

Three years (Six Semesters)

(I) Compulsory Courses: These courses are compulsory for all the students.

(a) English

(b) Assamese or Alt. English

(II) Major Courses: Major courses will have to be chosen by the students.

The courses shall be optional and non - mandatory.

English, Education, Political Science and Sociology.

(III) Non - Major Courses: Non- Major courses will have to be chosen by the students, who do not opt for major courses.

Education, Political Science, Sociology, History and Economics

(IV) Skilled Based Courses: Skill based courses are mandatory for all

students pursuing General Programme.

STRUCTURE OF COURSES FOR COMMERCE:

Three years (Six Semesters)

All papers are compulsory in the first two semesters. From third semester onwards the students can choose special papers on the performance in the concerned subjects.

Papers for the First semester : Business Communication, Business Regulatory Framework, Financial Accounting, Business Environment.

STRUCTURE OF COURSES

Three years (Six Semesters) Degree Course in Arts and Commerce.

(I) Compulsory Courses: These courses are compulsory for all the students. (a) English (b) Assamese or Alt. English

(II) Major Courses: Major Courses will have to be chosen by the students. The courses shall be English, Education, Political Science and Sociology.

(III) Non - Major Courses: Non- Major Courses will have to be chosen by the students from Education, Political Science, Sociology, History and Economics.

(IV) Skilled Based Courses: Skill Based Courses are mandatory for all students pursuing General Programme.

STRUCTURE OF COURSES

Bachelor of Arts:

The Bachelor of Arts Program has the following courses under the semester system

- (i) **Compulsory Courses:** These courses are the compulsory courses for all students of the programme concerned. The students have to opt the following two courses under the compulsory courses namely: (a) English (b) Alt. English or Assamese.
- (ii) **Major Courses:** Don Bosco College offers the following courses as Major:
(a) English (b) Education (c) Political Science (d) Sociology. A student has to choose one of these courses as Major course.
- (iii) **Non-Major Courses:** A student who pursues a Major course at Don Bosco College, need to opt for a Non-Major Course from among the following: a) Economics (b) Education (c) History (d) Political Science and (e) Sociology. However, a student cannot opt for the same subject in both Major and Non-Major.

Bachelor of Commerce:

A student who opts for the Commerce Program can join in either of the two specializations offered by the College, under Dibrugarh University: They are:

- a) Accounting and Finance
- b) Human Resource Management

Bachelor of Arts :

The Bachelor of Arts Program (Honors) has the following courses under the CBCS semester system
