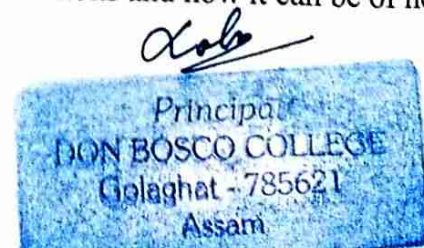
**d. Dr. Chandan Kumar Sharma**

He also said that idea of secularism is basic to its Constitution which is challenged by CAA. Assam has gone through demographic threat, which emerge several movements- issue of culture, economic rights, identity etc. CAA will be a very defining moment.
