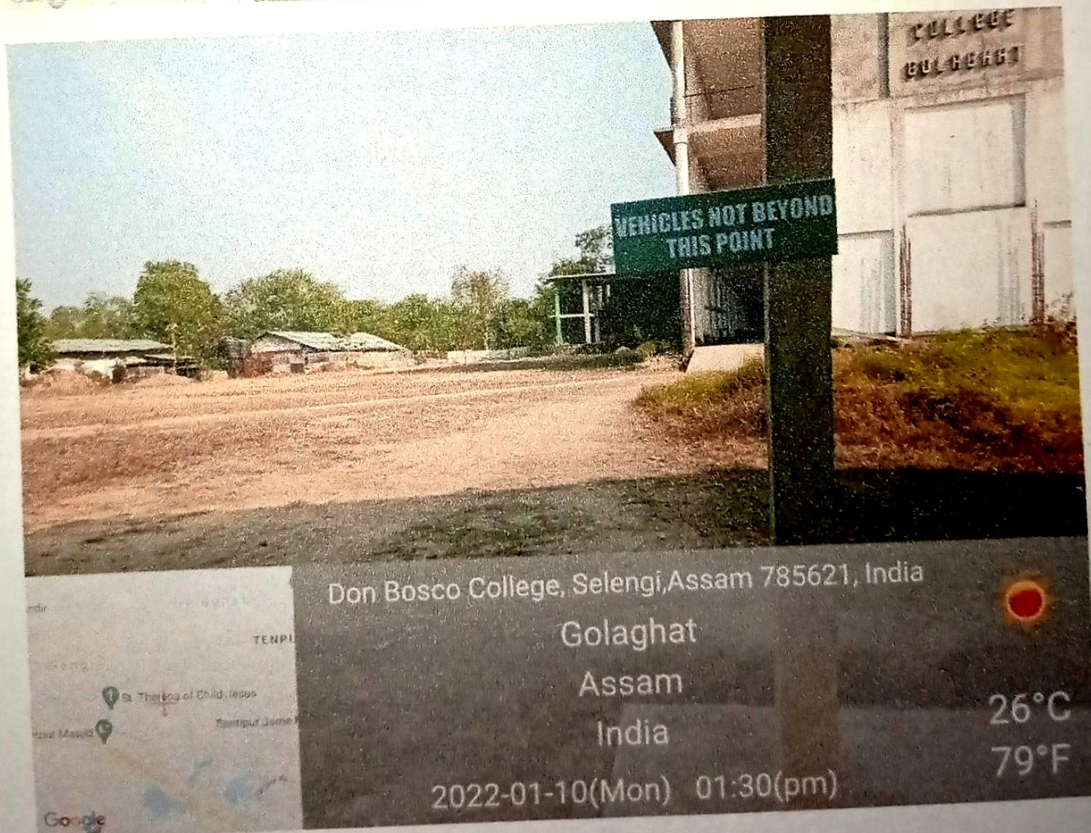

20 -25 August 2021: Don Bosco College, Golaghat carried out a week-long Tree Plantation Drive from 20 to 25 August, 2021. 1,000 tree saplings were purchased from Guwahati and planted in and around the campus. 350 Bokul trees, 200 Jacaranda trees of blue and pink colours, 100 Ashoka trees, 100 Crape Myrtles of pink and white colours, 100 Krishnachura, 50 Radhasura, 50 Nahor trees and 50 Purple Lagerstroemias were planted by 35 students during the week.



5 Jun 2018: Ms. Sushmita Rongpipi, the program officer of NSS Unit, Don Bosco College, Golaghat organised a very special program to inculcate values of Environment protection and preservation in the NSS volunteers. She collected various medicinal, aromatic and fruit bearing plants and organised the plantation of the same in the college campus.

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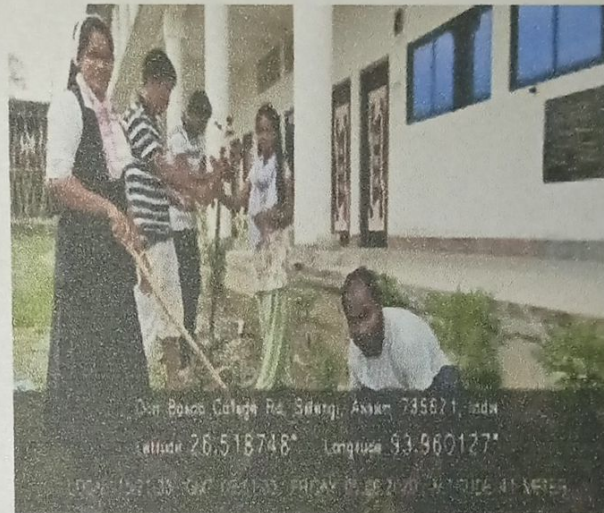

POLICY DOCUMENT ON GREEN CAMPUS

Don Bosco College, Golaghat should demonstrate higher sensitivity and responsibility in implementing green concepts in the campus. The campus sustainability initiatives is established with the aim of promoting green practices in and beyond the institution and develop best practices strategies in environmental management. Although establishment and maintenance of green campus is important, spreading awareness on the green practices among students and educating stake holders is our priority. The policy starts with information and ends with a plan of action. In turn, the college will fairly manage water resources, waste management, conserve natural resources, and provide eco- friendly and recommend minimal paper use. Institute will implement following practices towards establishment and maintenance of green campus and adopt the awareness and green initiatives beyond the campus too. This will result in safe environment that is a better place to live, learn and play.

Restricted entry of vehicles

- All the vehicles of college staff/ faculty members should be getting the emission certification before entering the vehicle in college campus.
- The college encourages the employees and students to frequently use public transport, bicycles, etc. to limit the emissions.

Water Management

- Always practice and implement rain water recycling and harvest rain water to resolve and manage water scarcity problems in future
- Protect environment towards climatic changes and conservation of sources for drinking water.
- Regularly inspect taps for draining and repair immediately to avoid loss of potable water.
- Promote effective water management drip pipe lines, recycling of drainage and rain water harvesting.

Waste Management

- Spread the awareness amongst society about the waste management for ecosystem and methods for its disposal.
- Promote the efforts for the conversion of waste into renewable energy

Renewable Energy

- Improve awareness about renewable energy
- Promote adaptation of solar power equipments/converters.
- Adopt and promote power saving electrical equipments
- Beware on the role of scientific electrification and the use of bulbs and equipments in saving of power

Green Building

- Promote and advocate the implementation of solar passive technology for sustainability and green concepts.
- Cleanliness in and around the campus and waste minimization Paperless Office
- Advocate the benefits of paperless work in reducing the waste production and green practices.
- Digital Library.

- According to institute policy and rules the use of tobacco products is treated as offence.

Green initiatives beyond the campus

- The Green Campus Programs beyond the campus should be encouraged and planned. Strong commitment and support from the Management will always be there for contribution to embedding sustainability in the campus and beyond the campus. Green Neighbourhood promotional programs will inculcate social skills in and bring awareness in communities to control pollution, save energy, practice on-site renewable energy methods and preserve agricultural and environmentally sensitive areas. Save Energy TIPS:

- Activate power management features on your computer and monitor so that it will go into a low power “sleep” mode when you are not working on it.
- Turn off your monitor when you leave your table.
- Activate power management features on your laser printer.
- Whenever possible, shut down rather than logging off.
- Turn off unnecessary lights and use daylight instead.
- Avoid the use of decorative lighting.
- Use LED or compact fluorescent bulbs.
- Keep lights off in conference rooms, classrooms, lecture halls when they are not in use.
- Use the fans only when they are needed.
- The college has to work out the time bound strategies to implement green campus initiatives for healthy ecosystems



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
